Who was really crying out, “Let this chalice pass from Me?”

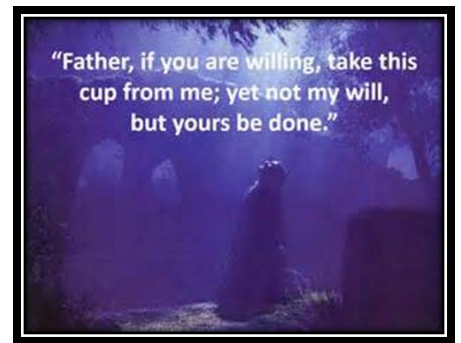
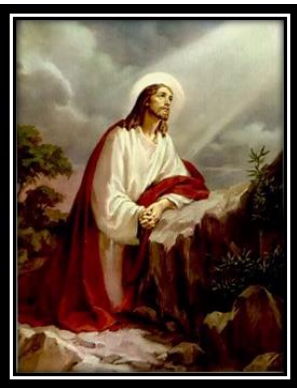
Volume 16, January 4, 1924, Page 40, (whole chapter)
